



Evildoers avoid light Truthdoers seek light

The light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. Sin blocks knowledge

Truth: follow it or forget it

For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing. (James 1:23-25)

Obeying aids understanding

- None of the wicked shall understand, but those who are wise shall understand. (Daniel 12:10)
- Start acting as though you believe, and you just might believe more strongly!
- If anyone's will is to do God's will, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I am speaking on my own authority. (John 7:17)
