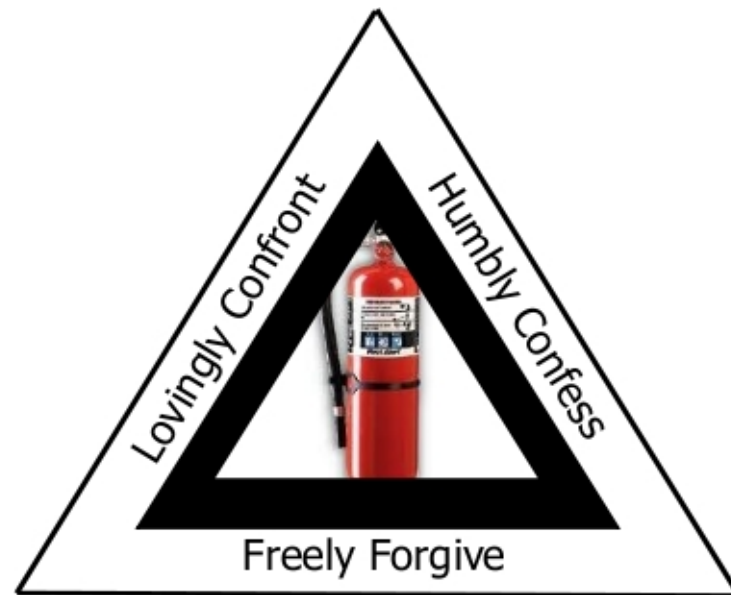

7 A's of Confession

Address everyone involved (All those affected by our sin);

Avoid if, but, and maybe (Don't excuse your wrongs);

Admit specifically (Both attitudes and actions);

7 A's of Confession



Acknowledge the hurt;

Accept the consequences (Such as making restitution);

Alter your behavior (Change your attitudes and actions);

Ask for forgiveness.
