- What's a "thorn in your flesh"? (2 Cor. 12:7b)
 - "Concerning this I implored the Lord three times that it might leave me. And He has said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." (2 Cor. 12:8-9a)
- "Love your neighbor as yourself" = Provide the solution to your own problem; then, make it available to your neighbor.
- Make value by forming/connecting what God has already made.
