- 1. He called them.

How might this work in your coaching?

- 1. Call your client to the task (establish that you are the disciple maker and the client is the disciple).
- 2. Show your client what you want him/her to learn.
- 3. Teach your client the agreed upon task.

How might this work in your coaching?

- 4. Send the client out to put into practice what was learned.
- 5. Reteach in the light of the client's experience.
- 6. Send the client out to put into practice what was learned.
- 7. Challenge the client to coach others.
