ACCOUNTABILITY

DEVELOPING URGENCY

1. Study passages in the Bible like John 3, John 4, Luke 15, Acts 2
2. Read books on how-to evangelism
3. Read biographies of people who have come to Christ
4. Specifically ask God for His heart to be your heart.

DEVELOPING URGENCY

5. Memorize and pray over verses like the following:

John 4:34, “Jesus said to them, ‘My food is to obey the will of the One Who sent Me, and to finish the work He gave me to do.’”

DEVELOPING URGENCY

5. Memorize and pray over verses like the following:

John 9:4, *“As long as it is day we must do the work of Him Who sent Me; night is coming when no one can work.”*

Romans 10:1, *“My friends, how I wish with all my heart that my own people might be saved. How I pray to God for them.”*

Jeremiah 9:1, *“Oh, that my head were a spring of water and my eyes a fountain of tears. I would weep day and night for the slain of my people.”*

DEVELOPING URGENCY

6. Intentionally work to understand unsaved people and their living.

7. Think through your vocal witness being rejected.

8. Discuss with others what your life would be without Jesus.
